

# ***Hanahan Bands Meeting Minutes***

June 11, 2007

## **I. Call to order**

**Steve Richards** called to order the regular meeting of the **Hanahan Band Boosters** at **7:00PM** on the **11<sup>th</sup> of June, 2007** in **Hanahan High School Band Room**. There were 32 people present at the meeting.

## **II. Roll call**

Heide Wittchow, Recording Secretary took attendance. The following board members were present: Steve Richards, Rebekah Davis, Anne Weast, Heide Wittchow, Heide Butts, Tammy Ballard, Lisa Seargant. Tori Davis and Joey Weast represented student leadership at the meeting.

## **III. Approval of minutes from last meeting**

Steve Richards shared that minutes were available from the last meeting, no minutes were read.

## **IV. Treasurer's Report**

a) The treasurer's report was provided by Anne Weast. We have a balance of \$21,522.90, not including a recent deposit of \$1600 from marching registrations.

## **V. New business**

- a) The 2007-2008 Budget was presented by Tammy Ballard. She provided a paper copy of the budget to all present. The budget would help alleviate students fair share costs from \$630 to \$300 for the year. She made it clear that the cost to parents could only remain that low provided we have full parent/student participation in fund raisers. The budget was voted on and approved by all present. There were no dissenting opinions.
- b) Fireworks booth will be set up in the parking lot of the Rivers Ave. Wal-Mart from June 25<sup>th</sup> through July 5<sup>th</sup>. This is a great money maker for the band. Lisa Seargant presented information regarding how the booth would function and passed around a volunteer form. She stated that we will also be doing this again in December for New Year's. It was recommended that all workers bring water with them and that parents would only be given credit for hours scheduled, unless unforeseen circumstances arrive (e.g. extremely busy, relief doesn't show up).
- c) All present were provided with a quarterly calendar to help keep track of upcoming summer band related events. Parents were asked to correct the dates of the Fireworks both to reflect the 25<sup>th</sup> through the 5<sup>th</sup> as opposed to the 29<sup>th</sup> through the 5<sup>th</sup>. Also, future calendars will reflect Sun-Mon format as opposed to Mon-Sun format.
- d) Anne Weast talked to parents about their responsibility to their students and about opportunities to help out within the band. She provided her phone number for people to call and talk to her about possible opportunities to help.

## **VI. Director's Report**

- a) Mr. Spittler thanked parents for coming and gave his cell phone number so parents could reach him as necessary. He provided a tentative schedule of events for the entire school year. He discussed the upcoming music for the band this year and indicated the title of the show was "Conflicts".
- b) Mr. Spittler also indicated that the band may receive a hefty sum of money to help offset some of the costs of the boosters for the school district. He advised parents to let their voices be heard at the July 14<sup>th</sup> budget meeting in the Berkeley County Board Room, Moncks Corner.
